

The Vietnam Education Foundation (VEF) sent 385 Fellows to study in the United States.

The People Online: In the afternoon of August 11, 2011 in Ho Chi Minh City, the Vietnam Education Foundation (VEF) organized a Press Meeting about the 3rd VEF Alumni Conference and the Fellowship Program for Cohort 2012. After 9 years of operation in Vietnam, the VEF Fellowship Program has sent 385 Vietnamese Fellows to study at 82 leading universities in the United States. VEF Fellows study in the fields of sciences, engineering, mathematics, medicine and technology, and then return to Vietnam to meet the demand of human resources for the country's development.

Under the VEF Fellowship Program, Cohort 2012, 45 new candidates have been selected to study at U.S. universities. Mr. David Duong, CEO of Vietnam Waste Solutions cum VEF Board Member, stated that VEF will open to various fields of study to attract more female candidates, balance better the ratio of candidates' regions all over the country. Recently, the Foundation has been making efforts toward the establishment of an American University in Vietnam.
