

45 applicants selected for the VEF Fellowship Program

On August 11, 2011 at Da Phuoc Integrated Waste Management Facility (Ho Chi Minh City), the Vietnam Education Foundation (VEF) announced that 45 among 76 candidates have been selected for the VEF Fellowship Program, Cohort 2012.

The selected ones succeeded in the interview conducted by the panelists including 12 U.S scientists and professors, who had the working visit to Vietnam from August 4-12, 2011. The new VEF Fellows will pursue their graduate programs at universities in the United States. Dr. Nguyen Thi Thanh Phuong, VEF Country Director, said that the percentage of selected candidates coming from the South and Central region of Vietnam is 60% for this year. On this occasion, VEF also made an announcement about the 3rd VEF Alumni Conference, which will be held from August 12-14 in Can Tho.

VEF is a special initiative of the U.S. Congress with the mission of bringing the two countries, United States and Vietnam, closer together through educational exchanges in science and technology.
